SECTION 4 FIRST AID MEASURES

EYE EXPOSURE: Immediately flush the eyes with copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. Assure flushing under eyelids. A victim may need assistance in keeping their eyelids open. Get immediate competent medical attention.

CONDITIONS FOR SAFE STORAGE: Air and moisture sensitive. Keep away from heat and sources of ignition. Do not allow to come into contact with water during storage. Store in a tightly sealed container. Recommended storage temperature is 2-8° C.
